Technique used: Crochet



YARN

Naturally Caron.com Country

75% Microdenier Acrylic/25% Merino Wool):

#0021 Peacock (MC), 3 skeins

#0012 Foliage (CC), 1 skein

One hook size US 1 - 9 (5.5mm) crochet hook, or size to obtain gauge.

Several small pieces of yarn for stitch markers
Yarn Needle

5 - ½" small plastic rings for buttons, or 5 small buttons

Printer Friendly instructions

SIZES: 12-18 months (2 years, 4 years)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest 24"(25", 28") / 61cm (63.5cm, 71cm)

GAUGE

In sc, using US size 1 - 9 (5.5 mm) hook, 15 sc and 18 rows = 4"

STITCHES USED

Single Crochet (sc)

Double Crochet (dc)

Half Double Crochet (hdc)

Reverse Single Crochet (rsc)

Slip Stitch (sl st)

Single Crochet 2 Together (sc2tog): Insert hook in next sc, yarn over and pull up a loop (two loops on hook), insert hook in next sc, yarn over and pull up a loop (three loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all three loops on hook.

Half Double Crochet 2 Together (hdc2tog): [Yarn over, insert hook in next st, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice (five loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all five loops on hook.

Reverse Single Crochet (rsc): Working from left to right, work a single crochet.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

Button Hole Stitch: sc in next sc on edge, ch 2, skip one st, sc in next st. On return row, sc in each sc and in each ch-2 sp.

ABBREVIATIONS

Back loop (bl)

POCKETS (make 2)

With CC, ch 13. Turn.

Row 1: skip first ch, sc in next ch and in each ch across. Ch 1 – (12 sc). Turn.

Row 2 (RS): Sc in first sc and in each sc across. Ch 1. Turn.

Rows 3 – 12: Repeat Row 2.

At the end of Row 12, end off, leaving long tail to sew Pocket on to Jacket.

Lay pockets flat, and block while you work the rest of the Jacket.

BACK

With MC, ch 45 (47, 51).

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across. Ch 1 – [44 (46, 50) sc]. Turn.

Row 2 (RS): sc in each sc across.

Rows 3 – 34 (36, 40): Repeat Row 2 until Back measures approx. 7 ½" (8", 9"), ending with a RS row. Mark both sides of last row for underarm.

Rows 35 (37, 41) – 54 (58, 64): Repeat Row 2 until Back measures approx. 12" (13", 14"), ending with a RS row. Do not end off.

SHOULDERS

Left shoulder

Row 1: sc in first sc and in each of next 9 (10, 12) scs. Sc2tog in next 2 sc. Ch 1 – [11 (12, 14) sc]. Turn.

Row 2: Sc2tog in first 2 sc, sc in next sc and in each sc across – [10 (11, 13)]. Fasten off. Turn.

Right shoulder

Row 1: After last sc on Row 1 of Left shoulder skip next 20 (20, 20) scs on last row of back. Join yarn in next sc. Sc2tog in same sc and next sc. Sc in each of next 10 (11, 13) scs. Ch 1 – [11, (12, 14) sc]. Turn.

Row 2: Sc in first sc and in each sc across to last two sc. Sc2tog – [10(11, 13)]. Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

With MC, ch 25 (27, 29).

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1 – [24, (26, 28) sc]. Turn.

Row 2: sc in each sc across. Ch 1. Turn.

Rows 3 – 34 (36, 40): Repeat Row 2 until Left Front measures approx. 7 ½" (8", 9") ending with RS row. Mark both sides of last row for underarm.

Rows 35 (37, 41) – 48 (52, 58): Repeat Row 2 until Left Front measures approx. 10 ½" (11 ½", 13"), ending with a RS row.

NECK

Row 1: sc in first sc and in each of next 12 (13, 15) scs. Sc2tog in next 2 scs. Ch 1 – [14 (15, 17)] sc. Turn.

Row 2: sc2tog in first 2 sc, sc in each sc across. Ch 1 – [13 (14,16)] sc. Turn.

Row 3: sc in first sc and in each sc across, until last two sc. Sc2tog in last two sc. Ch 1 – [12, 13, 15)] sc. Turn.

Row 4: sc2tog in first 2 sc, sc in each sc across. Ch 1 – [11 (12, 14)] sc. Turn.

Row 5: sc in first sc and in each sc across, until last two sc. Sc2tog in last two sc. Ch 1 – [10, (11, 13)] sc. Turn.

Row 6: Sc in each sc across. Finish off.

RIGHT FRONT

With MC, ch 25 (27, 29).

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1 – [24, (26. 28) sc]. Turn.

Row 2: sc in each sc across. Ch 1. Turn.

Rows 3 – 34 (36, 40): Repeat Row 2 until Right Front measures approx. 7 ½" (8", 9") ending with RS row. Mark both

sides of last row for underarm.

Rows 35 (37, 41) – 48 (52, 58): Repeat Row 2 until Right Front measures approx. 10 ½" (11 ½", 13"), ending with a RS row.

NECK

Row 1: sc2tog in first 2 sc, sc in each of next 13 (14, 16) scs. Ch 1 – [(14 (15, 17))] scs. Turn.

Row 2: sc in each sc across, until last 2 scs. Sc2tog in last two scs. Ch 1 – [13 (14, 16)] scs. Turn.

Row 3: sc2tog in first 2 sc, sc in each sc across. Ch 1 - [12 (13, 15)] scs. Turn.

Row 4: sc in first sc and in each sc across, until last 2 scs. Sc2tog in last two scs. Ch 1 – [11(12, 14)] scs. Turn.

Row 5: Sc2tog in first 2 sc, sc in each sc across. Ch 1 – [10 (11, 13)] scs. Turn.

Row 6: Sc in each sc across. Finish off.

BUTTON HOLES

Row 1: With RS facing, starting on bottom edge of Right Front, sc evenly along the edges of the rows, up to the neckline. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Mark the stitches for the buttonholes, placing the first marker a few rows down from the neckline, and spacing the rest evenly down the front, until a few rows from the bottom edge. Sc to the first marker. *Ch 2, skip 1 sc, sc in the next sc and in each sc until the next marker. Repeat from *, ending with sc in each sc to end of row. Ch 1, turn.

Row 3: Sc in each sc and ch-2 space across. Finish off.

Sew Pockets on Jacket fronts, 1 1/4" from bottom and sides.

With RS facing, Sew Front and Back together at shoulders.

LEFT SLEEVE

With RS facing, join yarn at underarm marker on LEFT FRONT. Ch 1, work 36 (36, 42) scs, evenly spaced, until marker on left edge of BACK. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Working this row in the front loop only (flo), sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn.

Rows 3 - 8: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 9: Sc2tog in first two scs, sc in each sc across until last 2 scs. Sc2tog in last 2 scs. Ch 1 – [34(34, 40)]. Turn.

Rows 10 – 15: Repeat Rows 3 – 8.

Row 16: Repeat Row 9. [32 (32, 38)].

Rows 17 – 22: Repeat Rows 3 – 8.

Row 23: Repeat Row 9. [30 (30, 36)].

Rows 24 – 29: Repeat Rows 3 – 8.

Row 30: Repeat Row 9. [28 (28, 34)].

Rows 31 – 36: Repeat Rows 3 – 8.

Row 37: Repeat Row 9. [26 (26, 32)].

Rows 38 – 43: Repeat Rows 3 – 8.

LARGE SIZE only:

Row 44: Repeat Row 9. (30 sc)

MEDIUM and LARGE SIZE only:

Rows 45 – 50: Repeat Rows 3 – 8.

LARGE SIZE only:

Row 51: Repeat Row 9. (28 sc)

Rows 52 – 54: Repeat Rows 3 – 5.

Sleeve should measure approx. 9 1/2", (10 1/2" , 12")

RIGHT SLEEVE

With RS facing, join yarn at underarm marker on right edge of BACK. Ch 1, work 36 (36, 42) scs, evenly spaced, until

marker on RIGHT FRONT. Ch 1, turn.
Repeat directions for left sleeve.

FINISHING

Sew side seams and sleeve seams.

NECK

You will be working along the two side curves only.

With MC, on WS, join yarn at the curve of the neck on one side.

Row 1: work 6 (7, 8) scs, evenly spaced, around curve. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Hdc in each of first 2 sc, hdc2tog in next 2 sc. Hdc in each sc to end – [5(6, 7) hdc]. End off.

Repeat for curve on other side.

EDGING

With CC, RS facing, work 1 round of sc around bottom edge of sleeve. Join with a slip stitch. Fasten off.

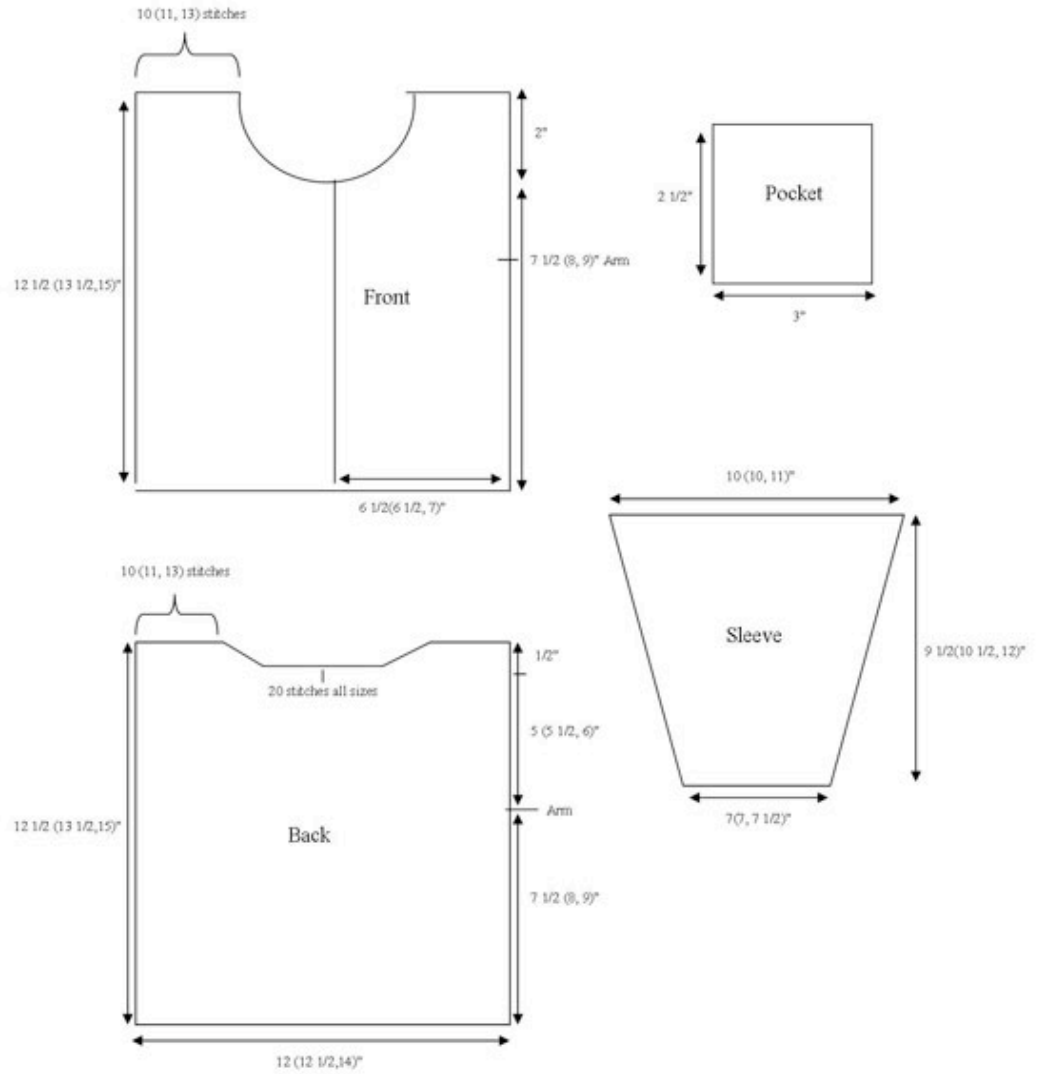
With CC, RS facing, join yarn at center of bottom edge of back. Work 1 round of sc, evenly spaced, around edge of entire sweater, working one sc in each st, three sc in each corner, and one sc in sides of each row, skipping every fourth row so there is no puckering. Join round with a slip stitch in top of first sc. Fasten off.

SLEEVE/SHOULDER BORDER

With CC, working in the bl of Row 2 of each sleeve, work 1 row RSC. Fasten off.

BUTTONS

With CC, using a tapestry needle, work Buttonhole St around each ring. Weave yarn through the stitches in the back, and sew on left front of sweater, evenly spaced. Or, use regular buttons.



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
