Technique used: Crochet



YARN

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75% Microdenier Acrylic/25% Merino Wool

3 oz/85 g, 185 yds/169 m skein):

11 (13, 14, 15) skeins.

**Shown in:** #0022 Plum Pudding

One size US G-6 (4mm) crochet hook,  
or size to obtain gauge.

Yarn needle

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### SIZES

Small (Medium, Large, X-Large)

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Bust 34 (38, 42, 46)"/86.5 (96.5, 106.5, 117) cm

Length 20"/51 cm

### GAUGE

In established pattern, using US G-6 (4mm) hook, long panel (before edging) = 7 1/2"/19 cm wide;  
10 1/2 rows = 4"/10 cm.

In double crochet, using G-6 (4mm) hook, 14 sts and 8 rows = 4"/10 cm.

In single crochet, using G-6 (4mm) hook, 16 sts and 16 rows = 4"/10 cm.

### STITCHES USED

Chain (ch), double crochet (dc), half double crochet (hdc), single crochet (sc), slip stitch (slip st)

### SPECIAL TERMS

**FPdc:** Front-post double crochet: Yarn over, insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of stitch, yarn over and draw up loop, complete as dc.

**BPdc:** Back-post double crochet: Yarn over, insert hook from back to front and then to back again around post of stitch, yarn over and draw up loop, complete as dc.

**FPtr:** Front-post treble crochet: [Yarn over] twice, insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, complete as tr.

**BPtr:** Back-post treble crochet: [Yarn over] twice, insert hook from back to front and then to back again around post of stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, complete as tr.

**BPc:** Back-post cable: Skip 3 sts, BPtr in next 3 sts, working behind the 3 BPtr just made, BPtr in the 3 skipped sts.

**FPc:** Front-post cable: Skip 3 sts, FPtr in next 3 sts, working behind the 3 FPtr just made, FPtr in the 3 skipped sts.

**sc2tog:** Single crochet 2 together – Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, (two loops on hook), insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through all three loops on hook.

**Cross Post:** Skip next st, FPdc around next st, working over st just made FPdc in skipped st.

### NOTES

1. Cardigan is made in three panels, with collar added after assembly; one short panel for center back, and two long panels for front and back right side, and front and back left side.

2. It can be difficult to work a back-post stitch behind stitches just made. Turning the work, working a front-post stitch and then turning the work back again produces the same results.

### LONG PANEL (make 2)

Chain 30.

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in fourth ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—28 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, (counts as hdc throughout), hdc in next st, skip next 3 sts, BPtr in next st; working in front of BPtr just made hdc in 3 skipped sts, [hdc in next st, BPdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st; work BPc over next 6 sts, [hdc in next st, BPdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts, working behind sts just made BPtr in skipped st (see Note #2), hdc in next 2 sts, turn—16 hdc, 4 BPdc, 8 BPtr.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts, working in front of sts just made, FPtr in skipped st, [hdc in next st, FPdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st, FPtr in next 6 sts, [hdc in next st, FPdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st, skip next 3 sts, FPtr in next st; working behind st just made hdc in 3 skipped sts, hdc in next 2 sts, turn—16 hdc, 4 FPdc, 8 FPtr.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, skip next 3 sts, BPtr in next st; working in front of BPtr just made hdc in 3 skipped sts, [hdc in next st, BPdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st, BPtr in next 6 sts, [hdc in next st, BPdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts, working behind sts just made, BPtr in skipped st, hdc in next 2 sts, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts; working in front of sts just made FPtr in skipped st, [hdc in next st, FPdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st, work FPc over next 6 sts, [hdc in next st, FPdc in next st] 2 times, hdc in next st, skip next 3 sts, FPtr in next st, working behind st just made; hdc in 3 skipped sts, hdc in next 2 sts, turn.

**Row 6:** Repeat Row 4.

**Row 7:** Repeat Row 3.

**Rows 8–103:** Repeat Rows 2–7.

**Row 104:** Ch 1, sc in each st across—28 sc. Fasten off.

### Left Front Panel

With RS facing, join yarn with sc in edge of first row of panel.

**Row 1:** Working along side edge of panel, sc in edge of same row, sc in next row, [2 sc in next row, sc in next row] to end, turn—156 sc.

### Medium (Large, X-Large) sizes only:

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in next 77 sts, turn.

**Next 0 (1, 2) Rows:** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

### All sizes:

Fasten off. Repeat on other Long Panel, beginning on WS of panel, for Right Front Panel

### Underarm Panel

With WS facing, join yarn with sc in edge of first row (on opposite side of panel from front edging).

**Row 1:** Working along side edge of panel, sc in edge of same row, sc in next row, [2 sc in next row, sc in next row] to end, turn—156 sc.

**Medium (Large, X-Large) sizes only:**

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in next 54 (53, 52, 51) sts; leave remaining sts unworked, turn—54 (53, 52, 51) sts.

**Next 0 (1, 2) Rows:** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

**All sizes:**

Fasten off. Repeat on other Long Panel (Right Front), beginning on RS of panel.

### SHORT BACK PANEL

**Small size only:**

Chain 10.

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook and each ch across, turn—8 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, work BPdc over next 6 sts, hdc in next st, turn—2 hdc, 6 BPtr.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, FPtr in next 6 sts, hdc in next st, turn—2 hdc, 6 FPtr.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, BPtr in next 6 sts, hdc in next st, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 2, work FPc over next 6 sts, hdc in next st, turn.

**Row 6:** Repeat Row 4.

**Row 7:** Repeat Row 3.

**Rows 8–49:** Repeat Rows 2–7.

**Rows 50 and 51:** Repeat Rows 2 and 3.

**Row 52:** Ch 1, sc in each st across—8 sc. Fasten off.

**Medium (Large) sizes only:**

Chain 18 (26).

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook and each ch across, turn—16 (24) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, [BPdc in next st, hdc in next st] 2 (4) times, work BPc over next 6 sts, hdc in next st, [BPdc in next st, hdc in next st] 2 (4) times, turn—6 (10) hdc, 4 (8) BPdc, 6 (6) BPtr.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, [FPdc in next st, hdc in next st] 2 (4) times, FPtr in next 6 sts, hdc in next st, [FPdc in next st, hdc in next st] 2 (4) times, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, [BPdc in next st, hdc in next st] 2 (4) times, BPtr in next 6 sts, hdc in next st, [BPdc in next st, hdc in next st] 2 (4) times, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 2, [FPdc in next st, hdc in next st] 2 (4) times, work FPc over next 6 sts, hdc in next st, [FPdc in next st, hdc in next st] 2 times, turn.

**Row 6:** Repeat Row 4.

**Row 7:** Repeat Row 3.

**Rows 8–49:** Repeat Rows 2–7.

**Rows 50 and 51:** Repeat Rows 2 and 3.

**Row 52:** Ch 1, sc in each st across—16 (24) sc. Fasten off.

**X-Large size only:**

Chain 30.

**Rows 1–49:** Work Rows 1–49 of Long Panel.

**Rows 50 and 51:** Work Rows 2 and 3 of Long Panel.

**Row 52:** Ch 1, sc in each st across—28 sc. Fasten off.

### Panel Edging

Join yarn with sc in edge of first row of panel.

**Row 1:** Working along side edge of panel, sc in edge of same row, sc in next row, [2 sc in next row, sc in next row] to end, turn—78 sc.

Repeat along opposite side edge of panel.

### ASSEMBLY

Arrange Short Back Panel between two Long Panels, and against short edges of front edging (see assembly diagram). With yarn needle, matching up stitches of Long Panels with stitches of Short Panel, whipstitch together through back loops only. For side seam; fold Long Panel in half. Matching up stitches of Long Panel and underarm panel, whipstitch together through back loops only through first 54 (53, 52, 51) sts of Long Panel leaving remaining stitches open for Sleeve. Repeat for

second side seam.

### SLEEVE

**Rnd 1:** With RS facing, join yarn with sc in any unworked st around armhole, sc in each st around, working 0 (2, 4, 6) sts in edge of underarm panel; join with slip st in first sc—48 (52, 56, 60) sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, dc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 2, FPdc in next st, [hdc in next st, FPdc in next st] around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

**Rnd 4:** Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 2, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc.

**Rnd 7:** [Skip next 2 (3, 3, 2) sts, FPtr around next st of Rnd 5; working behind st just made dc in 2 (3, 3, 2) skipped sts] around; join with slip st in first FPtr.

**Rnd 8:** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 9:** Repeat Rnd 5.

**Rnd 10:** Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 11:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc2tog, [sc in next 9 sts, sc2tog] 3 times, sc in each st to end; join with slip st in first sc—44 (48, 52, 56) sc.

**Rnd 12:** Repeat Rnd 5.

**Rnd 13:** Repeat Rnd 3.

**Rnd 14:** Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 15:** Repeat Rnd 11—40 (44, 48, 52) sc.

**Rnd 16:** Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 17:** [Work Cross Post over next 2 sts] to end; join with slip st in first dc.

**Rnd 18:** Working in back loops only, repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 19:** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 20:** Ch 3, FPtr in next st of Rnd 18, [dc in next st, FPtr in next st of Rnd 18] to end; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

**Rnd 21:** Ch 3, FPtr in next st of Rnd 19, [dc in next st, FPtr in next st of Rnd 19] to end; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

**Rnd 22:** Ch 3, FPtr in next st of Rnd 20, [dc in next st, FPtr in next st of Rnd 20] to end; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

**Rnd 23:** Working in back loops only, repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 24:** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 25:** Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 26:** Repeat Rnd 5.

**Rnd 27:** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 28:** Ch 3, FPtr in next st of Rnd 26, [dc in next st, FPtr in next st of Rnd 26] to end; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

**Rnd 29:** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 30:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc2tog, [sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog] 3 times, sc in each st to end; join with slip st in first sc—36 (40, 44, 48) sc.

**Rnd 31:** Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 32:** Working in back loops only, repeat Rnd 5.

**Rnd 33:** Repeat Rnd 5.

**Rnd 34:** Ch 2, FPdc in next st of Rnd 33, [hdc in next st, FPdc in next st of Rnd 33] to end; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

**Rnd 35:** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 36:** Ch 3, FPtr in next st of Rnd 34, [dc in next st, FPtr in next st of Rnd 34] to end, join with slip st in top of beg-ch.

**Rnd 37:** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 38:** Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 39:** Working in back loops only, repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 40:** Repeat Rnd 5.

**Rnd 41:** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 42;** Ch 3, FPtr in next st of Rnd 40, [dc in next st, FPtr in next st of Rnd 40] to end, join with slip st in top of beg-ch.

**Rnd 43 (begin cuff):** Repeat Rnd 6.

**Rnd 44:** Repeat Rnd 2. Fasten off.

### COLLAR

Chain 25.

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook and each ch across, turn—23 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, BPc over next 6 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, skip next 3 sts, BPtr in next st; working in front of BPtr just made hdc in 3 skipped sts, hdc in next st, BPdc in next st, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts; working behind sts just made BPtr in skipped st, hdc in next 2 sts, turn—14 hdc, 1 BPdc, 8 BPtr.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts; working in front of sts just made FPtr in skipped st, hdc in next st, FPdc in next st, hdc in next st, skip next 3 sts, FPtr in next st; working behind FPtr just made hdc in 3 skipped sts, hdc in next 2 sts, FPtr in next 6 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, BPtr in next 6 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, skip next 3 sts, BPtr in next st; working in front of BPtr just made hdc in 3 skipped sts, hdc in next st, BPdc in next st, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts, working behind sts just made BPtr in skipped st, hdc in next 2 sts, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts; working in front of sts just made FPtr in skipped st, hdc in next st, FPdc in next st, hdc in next st, skip next 3 sts, FPtr in next st; working behind FPtr just made hdc in 3 skipped sts, hdc in next 2 sts, work FPc over next 6 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, turn.

**Row 6:** Repeat Row 4.

**Row 7:** Ch 2, hdc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next 3 sts; working in front of sts just made FPtr in skipped st, hdc in next st, FPdc in next st, hdc in next st, skip next 3 sts, FPtr in next st; working behind FPtr just made hdc in 3 skipped sts, hdc in next 2 sts, FPtr in next 6 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, turn.

**Rows 8–109 (109, 115, 121):** Repeat Rows 2–7.

**Row 110 (110, 116, 122):** Repeat Row 2.

**Medium (Large) sizes only:**

**Rows 111 (117)–113 (119):** Repeat Rows 3–5.

**All sizes:**

**Row 111 (114, 120, 123):** Ch 1, sc in each st across.

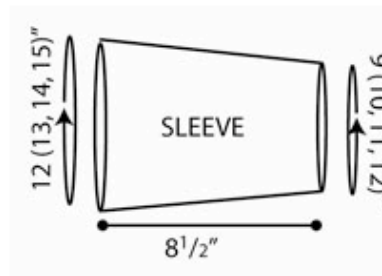
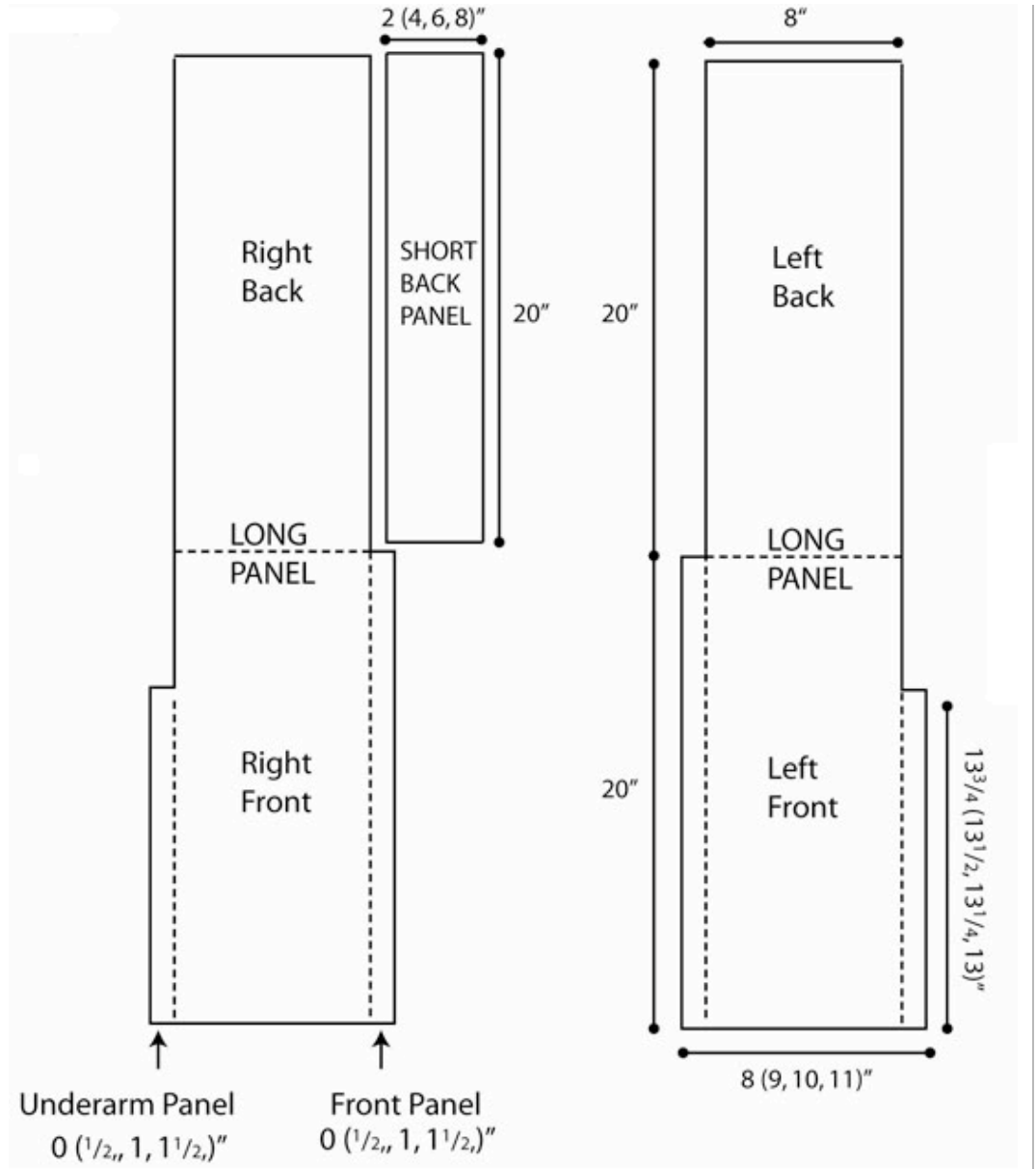
### Edging

With RS facing, join yarn with sc in edge of first row of Collar.

**Row 1:** Working along side edge of Collar, sc in edge of same row, sc in next row, [2 sc in next row, sc in next row] to end. Fasten off. Repeat on other edge of Collar.

### FINISHING

With yarn needle, matching up stitches of Collar with stitches of right front panel, right sides together, whipstitch together through back loops only, continue in same manner around sts at neck and left front panel. Weave in all ends.



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
