## Toulouse Wrap

designed by  
Andrea Graciarena



Technique used: Crochet



INTERMEDIATE

MATERIALS

[Naturally Caron.com Country](#)

(75% Microdenier Acrylic/25% Merino Wool; 3 oz/85g, 185yds/169m skein):  
14 oz

Shown in: #0012 Foliage

One size US I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook, or size to  
obtain gauge.

Yarn needle

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wrap measures approximately 16"/40.5cm wide x 51"/129.5cm long

### GAUGE

In pattern, 15 sts and 6 rows = 4"/10cm

Gauge is not critical for this project.

### STITCHES USED

Chain (ch), double crochet (dc), double treble crochet (dtr), single crochet (sc), slip stitch (sl st), treble crochet (tr),

### SPECIAL TERMS

**dc3tog:** Double crochet 3 together—[Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

**sc2tog:** Single crochet 2 together—Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, (2 loops on hook), insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook. **Note:** In this design, the sc2tog

span 3 sts, 2 ch-1 sps and a tr7tog. One loop is drawn up in each of the 2 ch-1 sps, and the tr7tog between the 2 ch-1 sps is skipped.

**sc3tog:** Single crochet 3 together—[Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

**beg tr4tog:** Beginning treble crochet 4 together—Ch 4, \*[yarn over] twice, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops] twice; repeat from \* 2 more times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

**tr7tog:** Treble crochet 7 together—\*[Yarn over] twice, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops] twice; repeat from \* 6 more times, yarn over and draw through all 8 loops on hook.

**tr4tog:** Treble crochet 4 together—\*[Yarn over] twice, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops] twice; repeat from \* 3 more times, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook.

**V-st:** V-stitch—(Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated stitch or space.

## NOTES

1. Wrap and ruffle are worked in one piece from top edge down to ruffle.
2. The top edging is worked, across opposite side of foundation chain, after body of Wrap is complete.

## WRAP

Ch 196.

**Row 1 (RS):** [Yarn over] twice, insert hook in 5th ch from hook and draw up a loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops] twice (2 loops on hook), \*[yarn over] twice, insert hook in next ch and draw up a loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops] twice; repeat from \* once more, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook (beg tr4tog made), ch 1, [dtr in next ch, ch 1] twice, (dtr, ch 1, dtr) in next ch, ch 1, [dtr in next ch, ch 1] twice, \*\*tr7tog over next 7 ch, ch 1, [dtr in next ch, ch 1] twice, (dtr, ch 1, dtr) in next ch, ch 1, [dtr in next ch, ch 1] twice; repeat from \*\* across to last 4 ch, tr4tog over last 4 ch, turn—16 ripples.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp, working in front loops only, sc in next 11 sts, \*sc2tog over next 2 ch-1 sps (skip the tr7tog between the 2 ch-1 sps), working in front loops only, sc in next 11 sts; repeat from \* across to last 2 sts, sc2tog over last ch-1 sp and beg tr4tog, turn—193 sc.

**Row 3:** Beg tr4tog, ch 1, [dtr in next sc, ch 1] twice, (dtr, ch 1, dtr) in next sc, ch 1, [dtr in next sc, ch 1] twice, \*tr7tog over next 7 sc, ch 1, [dtr in next sc, ch 1] twice, (dtr, ch 1, dtr) in next sc, ch 1, [dtr in next sc, ch 1] twice; repeat from \* across to last 4 sc, tr4tog over last 4 sc, turn.

**Rows 4–20:** Repeat Rows 2 and 3 eight times, then repeat Row 2 once more. Do not fasten off.

## Ruffle

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), [dc in next sc, ch 1] twice, [V-st in next sc, ch 1] twice, [dc in next sc, ch 1] 3 times, [V-st in next sc, ch 1] twice, dc in next sc, ch 1, \*dc3tog over next 3 sc, ch 1, dc in next sc, ch 1, [V-st in next sc, ch 1] twice, [dc in next sc, ch 1] 3 times, [V-st in next sc, ch 1] twice, dc in next sc, ch 1; repeat from \* across to last 2 sc, dc2tog over last 2 sc, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] 3 times, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] 3 times, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, sk next ch-1 sp, \*dc3tog over next 3 dc (skipping the ch-1 sps between the dc sts), ch 1, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] 3 times, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, sk next ch-1 sp; repeat from \* across to last 4 sts, dc2tog over next 2 dc (skipping the ch-1 sp between the dc sts); leave the turning ch unworked, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch, V-st in next dc, ch 1] 4 times, [sk next ch, dc in next dc, ch 1] 3 times, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] 4 times, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, \*dc3tog over next 3 dc (skipping the ch-1 sps between the dc sts), ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, [sk next ch, V-st in next dc, ch 1] 4 times, [sk next ch, dc in next dc, ch 1] 3 times, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] 4 times, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; repeat from \* across to last 4 sts, dc2tog over next 2 dc (skipping the ch-1 sp between the dc sts); leave the turning ch unworked, turn.

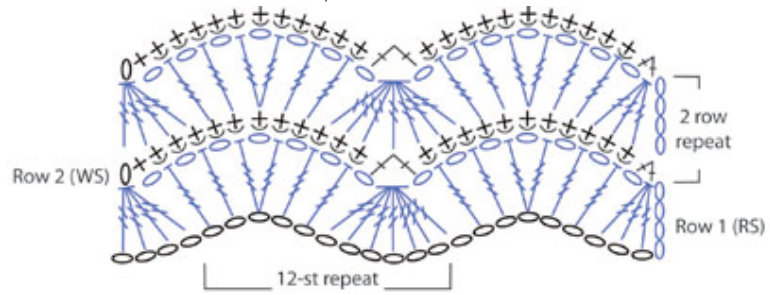
**Row 4:** Ch 3, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] twice, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, \*dc3tog over next 3 dc (skipping the ch-1 sps between the dc sts), ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, [sk next ch-1 sp, V-st in next dc, ch 1] twice, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; repeat from \* across to last 4 sts, dc2tog over next 2 dc (skipping the ch-1 sp between the dc sts); leave the turning ch unworked, turn. Fasten off.

**FINISHING**

**Top Edging**

With RS facing and working across opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with sc in first ch, sc in same ch, sc in next 4 ch, sc3tog over next 3 ch, \*sc in next 4 ch, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 4 ch, sc3tog over next 3 ch; repeat from \* across to last 4 ch, sc in next 3 ch, 2 sc in last ch. Fasten off.

Using yarn needle, weave in all ends. Block wrap, if desired.

⌋⌋⌋⌋⌋ = treble crochet 7 together (tr7tog)

⌋⌋⌋⌋ = beginning treble crochet 4 together (beg tr4tog)
